## Graduation Ceremony

LEC's 2017 Graduation Ceremony will commence at 7pm, Tuesday, June 27 at the Langley Fine Arts Theatre (Chief Sepass Theatre, Fort Langley). The cost to register is \$40 (payable online—see below) and includes gown, mortarboard cap rental (you get to keep the cap!), refreshments, and tickets for family and friends! When registering, please let us know how many tickets you would like to reserve (up to 4 tickets...extra tickets may become available at a later date) and your grad gown size.

## College and University application Info...

For **UFV** the deadline for semester based open application is on-going until programs are full.

For **Kwantlen Polytechnic University** the deadline for semester based open application is Friday, March 31.

**\*\*\*Please note** Nursing (BSN) at Kwantlen has a unique application schedule—please see [www.kwantlen.ca/health/bscn/faqs.html](http://www.kwantlen.ca/health/bscn/faqs.html) for more information. **\*\*\***

For all other colleges and universities—please consult their respective calendars in LEC's student area, or check their websites. If you need more information, or are unsure of your program application deadline—see the counsellor.

If you would like to apply for any BC college or university, direct your Internet browser to: [www.applybc.ca](http://www.applybc.ca) and follow the on-line prompts. Please be aware that application fees apply and range from \$40 – \$75. This may be paid on-line using a credit card. Questions!/? See the counsellor!

**TIP:** When applying on-line for college or university, please provide an email address that you know you will have for the foreseeable future. Consider printing out college emails and keeping them organized in a binder. Highlight important information such as dates and times for self-reporting your grades.

\*\*\* If you are not sure what this is about but plan to graduate this year—see Counsellor Mark!!

**Attention: Students going to College or University for September 2017.**

**You must submit your PSI Choices Form to the Ministry of Education.**

Your B.C. College or University must be able to access your interim and final grades in order to give you an offer of admission. In order for your college or university of application to do so you must give them permission. You do this by logging into the Ministry of Education Student Secure website @ <https://www.bced.gov.bc.ca/exams/tsw/tsw/student> (the same website you use to access your exam marks and unofficial transcripts) and click “Post Secondary Institution Selections”.

1) Students can either create an account or log in to an existing account. You will need you PEN number to access the form.

2) Under the “Trax (Transcript and Examination)” -> Select: “**Post Secondary Institution Selections**”

3) Next under PSI Selections -> Choose: “**Select PSI’s**”

4) Now check the “YES” box to “Forward my transcript to all BC Electronic PSI’s”

5) Confirmation – “Check” the box that gives the Ministry of Education permission to release your school and exam results to the Post Secondary Institutions indicated.

6) Current PSI Selection – Double check that you selected the correct institutions.

If you do not have an account with the above website—you will need to create one. You will need your **PEN** number to create the account (this 9 digit number is on your report card, or ask at the office).

Please do this as soon as possible.

**Your PSI Choices Form should be submitted no later than Sunday, March 26.**

You may select a maximum of 6 institutions. After submitting your selection, you will receive an email confirmation for reference. If you have questions about this process or you do not see your institution(s) listed on the PSI form—please see Mark (Counsellor).
